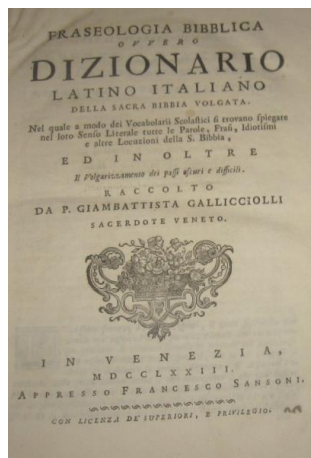

Conference general themes

Phraseology as a discipline covers the study of multi-word structures, set and fixed expressions and phraseological units. The latter includes phenomena as collocations, locutions, maxims, idioms etc.

Paremiology is concerned with proverbs referred to as short, well known pithy sayings that state general truths or pieces of advice.

Phraseology and paremiology have developed as disciplines in the early years of the twentieth century.

The 2nd International Conference on Phraseology and Paremiology, organized by the University of Cagliari in partnership with the association PHRASIS and is seen as a continuation of the Verona event by highlighting the history of the above-mentioned disciplines and their evolution in the different European and extra European Areas.

The linguistic history of each Country is heavily influenced by dictionaries (monolingual and bilingual), literary and scientific works which underline, implicitly or explicitly, with the phraseological nature of each language.

In this way, the study of Phraseology and Paremiology is also important from a cultural perspective. By focussing on synchronic and diachronic studies, we can discover something more of the history of these disciplines and also become aware of the language history of the human species.
