Call for papers (I)

The VII International conference of *Phrasis* Association aims at bringing together researchers, and scholars who are interested in the relationship between phraseological/paremiological units and specialized terminologies.

The phraseological and paremiological units occurring in specialised languages, their semantic and morphosyntactic properties and their relationship with the units occurring in general languages will be addressed, as well as their cognitive foundations, their lexicographic and terminographic representation, how they can be included in a didactic context (particularly in a contrastive framework) and their function within discourse.

The conference will be organized around the following thematic lines:

- phraseology, paremiology and terminology
- phraseology, paremiology and specialised languages
- phraseology, paremiology, terminology and diachronic variation
- phraseology, paremiology, terminology and lexicography
- phraseology, paremiology, terminology and terminography
- phraseology, paremiology, terminology and corpus linguistics
- phraseology, paremiology, terminology and new technologies
- phraseology, paremiology, terminology and contrastive studies
- phraseology, paremiology, terminology and discourse analysis
- phraseology, paremiology, terminology and political language
- phraseology, paremiology, terminology and specialized translation
- phraseology, paremiology, terminology and language teaching/learning of languages at various levels.

New research topic areas are equally welcome.

→How to apply

Authors may submit proposals for the presentation of papers or posters by filling in the application form they can find on the Phrasis Association's website (www.phrasis.it) by **April 25th, 2020** with the following data:

- Total number of authors
- Name(s) of author(s)
- Author/authors' e-mail address
- Author/s' CV (max 1000 characters)
- Affiliation (University or Institution)
- Title of paper or poster
- Topic
- Abstract (max 2000 characters)
- Keywords (3 to 5)
- Bibliography (max 5 titles)

Once all the fields have been filled in, the SEND button must be clicked.

No other sending method will be taken into consideration.

It should be noted that the submission of proposals does not constitute an automatic registration to the conference, which must be regularised only after having received the notification of acceptance from the Scientific Committee.

→Notification of acceptance

All submitted abstract will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee and notification of acceptance will be sent by **May 15th, 2020**.

Presentations will last 30 minutes (20 minutes of presentation + 10 minutes for discussion).

Posters will be exposed during the days of the conference and must be printed in A0 format.

→Publication of contributions

After a careful examination of all the manuscripts by the Scientific Committee, a selection of contributions will be published in a monographic volume,

→Registration fees

- **16 May 2020 - 29 June 2020:** 100 euros for Professors and researchers (70 euros for Phrasis members*); 50 euros for posters, PhD students and Temporary Research Fellows.
- **30 June 2020 - 31 July 2020:** 120 euros for Professors and researchers (90 euros for Phrasis members*); 60 euros for posters, PhD students and Temporary Research Fellows.

Important: In case of multi-authored submissions, every author must register and pay the due registration fee.

***Only members in good standing with membership fees can benefit from the reduced rate.**

→Registration fee and confirmation

The registration fee must be paid by bank transfer. Authors must follow the information on the Association's website (<http://www.phrasis.it/scheda/>).

In order to confirm the registration, authors must send by **July 31st, 2020** an e-mail to **phrasis2020.padova@phrasis.it** with a **copy of the Conference registration form** and a **copy of the bank transfer**.

In case of inability to pay by bank transfer, it is possible to pay on the day of the conference as long as the participant sends a request to **phrasis2020.padova@phrasis.it** by **July 31st, 2020**.

Papers and posters of authors who do not register by the **July 31st, 2020**) will not be accepted.
